





Brief Report:

The first woman to do doctorate in France, to do doctorate in science in the whole of the continent of Europe, to win a Nobel Prize, to win two Nobel Prizes in two different fields of science (Physics and Chemistry), to be a Professor in Sorbonne University and to be a mother Nobel laureate of a daughter Nobel laureate was no one else but Madam Curie.
