Brief report:

Wetlands are rich in biodiversity and are a habitat for a dense variety of plants and animal species. Each year on February 2, around the globe, it is celebrated as World Wetland Day to mark the date of the adoption of the Convention on Wetlands, on 2 February 1971, in the Iranian city of Ramsar. An intergovernmental treaty called 'The Convention on Wetlands' was signed in 1971 to provide framework for the national action and international cooperation for the conservation and the wise use of wetlands and their resources.
