General Instructions:

- (1) The themes of the competition will be announced at **12.15pm**.
- (2) Participants shall bring their own digital camera along with the transfer/USB cable to transfer the photographs in our pen drive/computer.
- (3) Pictures clicked with a mobile phone will also be accepted.
- (4) The participant will have to submit his/her best 3 pictures of the given theme.
- (5) Submitted photograph must not have any kind of signature/logo/copyright mark etc.
- (6) By submitting an image for the competition, the participants will be regarded as having granted the Institute to use the image in print, broadcast and /or electronic media in future.
- (7) Only minor colour correction and cropping of the image up to 20% will be allowed as post processing. The participant must submit the original unedited and untouched file of the picture along with the edited photo.
- (8) While submitting the image, the participants must provide the following details:
 - Rename your file with **Surname_Name_Roll No.**
 - Participants should provide following details in word doc/pdf along with the image:
 - i) Details of camera/device used for photography
 - ii) Caption and a brief description of photograph reflecting essence of the theme (in about 30 words)

(9) The photographs will be evaluated by the panel of judges and their decision shall be final.


(10) Judges will consider the following details of each image:

- technical (exposure; depth of field; colour or tonal rendition; contrast; and lighting)
- visual and aesthetic appeal.
- content (mood; emotion; relevance; subject; impact)
- general characteristics (originality; style; context; photographic vision)
